<b>Mark 7:6</b> - He replied, "Isaiah was right when he prophesied about you hypocrites; as it is written: 'These people honor me with their lips, but their hearts are far from me."
* Repentance is a change of heart AND mind that results in a change of
<b>Acts 26:20 -</b> First to those in Damascus, then to those in Jerusalem and in all Judea, and then to the Gentiles, I preached that they should repent and turn to God and demonstrate their repentance by their deeds.
* Becoming a Christ follower doesn't make you to sin.
<b>Romans 8:12-13 -</b> Therefore, brothers and sisters, we have an obligation—but it is not to the flesh, to live according to it. For if you live according to the flesh, you will die; but if by the Spirit you put to death the misdeeds of the body, you will live.
* Intentional continual sin is with new life in Christ.
