Luke 2:8 And there were shepherds living out in the fields

nearby,
What is a misfit? "someone who is not suited to a situation, orwho is not accepted by other people because something about them is considered"
The story of the Gospel is a gut wrenching, throat clutching, tear squeezing reality. God the fathersent that little boy, that little baby boy!
The son of Godwhose only experience was glory, chooses to come to a place most
Shepherds? They're not on anybody's list When the baby is bornthey are the first to know.

Revelation 3:15-18 15 I know your deeds, that you are neither cold nor hot. I

wish you were either one or the other.

Do you understand that the only peopleare those who know that they are wretched, pitiful, poor, blind and naked."
2. When God reaches themheto them.
Luke 2:9 An angel of the Lord appeared to them, and the glory of the Lord shone around them, and they were terrified.
Luke 2:13-14 Suddenly a great company of the heavenly host appeared with the angel, praising God and saying, "Glory to God in the highest heaven, and on earth peace to those on whom his favor rests."
Glory is where God Where common people gain a glimpse. Where you catch hold of the apron of His wonder. ThenYou attempt to honor what you observe.
That's the point of the entire experience that began in Bethlehemit was the 'fullness of time'. Time where God chooses to display what He looks liketo make what was mysterious, evident and obvious. This is called
John 1:14,18 ¹⁴ The Word became flesh and made his dwelling among us. We have seen his glory, the glory of the one and only Son, who came from the Father, full of grace and truth.
¹⁸ No one has ever seen God, but the one and only Son, who is himself God and is in closest relationship with the Father, has made him known.
Thethe greater is the God who saves him.
