- Why is there a lack of tangible evidence of God's existence?
- Why does God allow evil?
- Why are there people who say they believe in God but behave hypocritically to their beliefs?
  - \* When looking for evidence to believe in God, it can be found. When looking for evidence or any reason not to believe in God, there's some of that as well.
