### "In conclusion..."

As Jesus brings the Sermon on the Mount to a close, He offers **five** clear warnings and admonitions for His followers to both heed and pay attention too.

#### 1. Be aware of who & what \_\_\_\_\_ vou.

Acts 17:11 - Now the Berean Jews were of more noble character than those in Thessalonica, for they received the message with great eagerness and examined the Scriptures every day to see if what Paul said was true.

Matthew 7:2 - For in the same way you judge others, you will be judged, and with the measure you use, it will be measured to vou.
