1 Corinthians 12:1 Now, dear brothers and sisters, regarding your question about the special abilities the Spirit gives us. *I don't want you to misunderstand this.*

v4 There are different kinds of spiritual gifts, but the **same Spirit** is the source of them all. **5** There are different kinds of service, but we serve the **same Lord**.

6 God works in different ways, but it is the **same God** who does the work in all of us. **7** A spiritual gift is *given to each of us so we can help each other.*

v11 It is the one and only Spirit who distributes all these gifts. *He alone decides* which gift each person should have.
